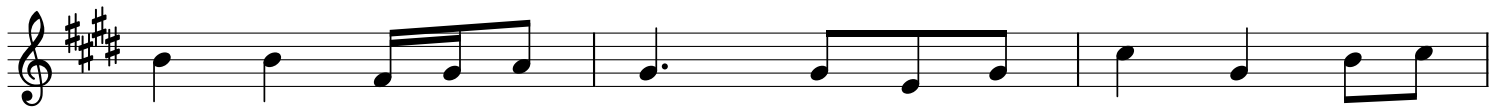


# This Body in the Grave We Lay
